- 1. Cover the tissue box and the foil tube with coloured paper using glue or cello tape (Make sure not to cover the hole in the tissue box.)
- 2. Cut a hole the size of your foil tube on one end of the tissue box. Put about 2 cm of the tube inside the tissue box. Use cello tape to keep it in place..
- 3. Pull the rubber bands over the long side of the tissue box with the hole side up.
- 4. Slide the ice block sticks under the rubber bands on each side of the hole and secure with glue.
- 5. Decorate your ukulele with crayons and you're ready to rock!


